ADJUSTMENT OF STORAGE SCALES FOR DOMESTIC IMPORT CONTAINERIZED CARGO

Kenya Ports Authority wishes to announce to customers in the Domestic Market (Kenya) the *Adjustment of Storage Scales* for import containerized cargo handled at the Port of Mombasa and Inland Container Depots (ICDs). This is aimed at simplifying the storage regime and easing tariff interpretation among users of our services and facilities.

The *Storage Scales* used to compute storage charges have been reduced from four to two scales as follows:

	Domestic Import Containers
1st Scale	5 to 21 days
2nd Scale	Over 21 days

Therefore, containers destined to the Domestic Market remaining in KPA's premises in excess of the 4-day Free Period shall accrue storage charges as follows:

	<u>RATE IN USD PER DAY OR PART THEREOF</u>	
	<u>20'</u>	<u>40'</u>
Domestic Import Containers:		
- First 4 consecutive days	Free	Free
- Thereafter, applicable rates for storage charges per day will be:		
5 to 21 days	30.00	60.00
Over 21 days	45.00	90.00

This takes effect from **15th September 2023**.
